



Chiclayo and Chaparrí Private Reserve

Chiclayo is one of several thriving cities in the northern coast of Peru with a rich cultural legacy from the great pre-Inca civilizations of the area. The basis of its economy, the productivity of its coastal valleys, goes back to the times of pre-Inca regional kingdoms. Its geographic location makes it a point of entrance to the northern Andes and to the northern jungle of Peru. Chiclayo boasts the most impressive museum in the country. It houses a silver and gold collection found in the nearby Pyramids of Ispahán, 35 km. from the city in Huaca Rajada, the site where the tomb of the Lord of Sipán, a great northern ruler, was discovered.

Suggested Itinerary

Day 1 | Chiclayo

At arrival transfer to the hotel. After check in, we visit the incredible Tucume ruins, then the Lord of Sipán Royal Museum and the Sicán Pyramid area, back to Chiclayo in the late afternoon. The lunch is included at Lambayeque.

Days 2 & 3 | Chiclayo – Chaparrí

2 days in the Chaparrí private reserved, this reserve counts with the biggest amount of endemic birds in Peru, where they have a project to re-insert the spectacle bear and white winged guan.

Day 3 | Transfer out

Returning to Chiclayo on day 3. Transfer out.

All transfers, 3 stars hotel with breakfast in Chiclayo 1 night, Chaparrí Private Reserve 1 night entrance fee to all attractions, flight Lima - Chiclayo - Lima and taxes.

Meals:
