



## Cusco & the Sacred Valley

Cusco, the capital of the Inca empire, without a doubt one of the best tourist destinations on earth, is one of the most beautiful cities in the American continent. Its unique mixture of cultures has given this place the perfect atmosphere for any tourist. There are no words to describe Cusco and its attractions, but we must mention Machu Picchu, one of the wonders of civilization, and the beauty of the Sacred Valley of the Incas, with towns like Pisac (with its handcraft market) and Ollantaytambo. You will marvel at the ruins of the Sacsaywaman fortress, the Temple of the Sun, the Temple of Wiracocha, and the Cusco Cathedral. The Inca trail is one of the best treks on earth; you can also visit the Lares Valley and its lost communities, or the amazing Choquequirao, near the department of Apurimac. This sacred city of the Incas was discovered in the XX century, and it is still not part of conventional tourism. You will surely be dazzled by the variety of festivities, processions, Inca ceremonies, and local food and drink that you will be able to experience day by day. The Sacred Valley of the Incas, originally call Yucay by the Incas, is located in Cusco department and it spreads along the Vilcanota river, cover the area between the towns of Pisac and Ollantaytambo. With an altitude of 2800 meters above sea level, and a temperate climate, with 2 very defined seasons, the rainy season and the dry season, very few places competed with richness of this valley, chosen by the ancient Peruvians. Nowadays a tourist destination that you can't miss, to enjoy the beauty of the landscape, the high content of history and culture, plus the chances to do extreme sports and adventure.



## Suggested Itinerary

### Day 1 | Lima - Cusco - Pisac

Transfer to Lima airport and flight to Cusco in the morning. At arrival to Cusco transfer to our hotel in Pisac town on the sacred Valley of the Incas for acclimatizing. Afternoon walk into town and the nearby points of interest. Dinner included.

### Day 2 | Pisac - Ollantaytambo

In the morning visit to the archeological complex of Pisac and walk to downtown Pisac, and then free time to shop in the famous handcraft market here. Lunch included on the way Pisac- Urubamba in Tunupa restaurant (novo-andina cuisine), visit to artist Pablo Seminario's house and to the Ollantaytambo complex. Overnight in Ollantaytambo.

### Day 3 | Ollantaytambo - Machu Picchu

In the morning train to Aguas Calientes, at arrival transfer to our hotel. For the afternoon we have the visit to Mandor water falls. Return to Aguas Calientes and overnight there

#### Day 4 | Machu Picchu - Cusco

Morning visit to Machu Picchu complex at sunrise and then time free to enjoy the complex on your own. In the afternoon return to Aguas Calientes and train to Ollantaytambo, from there bus to our hotel in Cusco. Night free.

#### Day 5 | Cusco

City tour in the morning which includes visit to Sacsayhuaman, Qenco, Puca Pucara and Tambomachay complexes, as well as the Temple of the Sun or Koricancha and the Cathedral in Cusco. Afternoon free. We include dinner with the delicious cuisine of fallen Angel restaurant. Night free.

#### Day 6 | Cusco

Day free to do your own search in the Imperial Capital of the Incas, its restaurants, bar and pubs. We suggest a visit to the traditional district of San Blas or the Pre-spaniard art museum.

#### Day 7 | Cusco - Lima

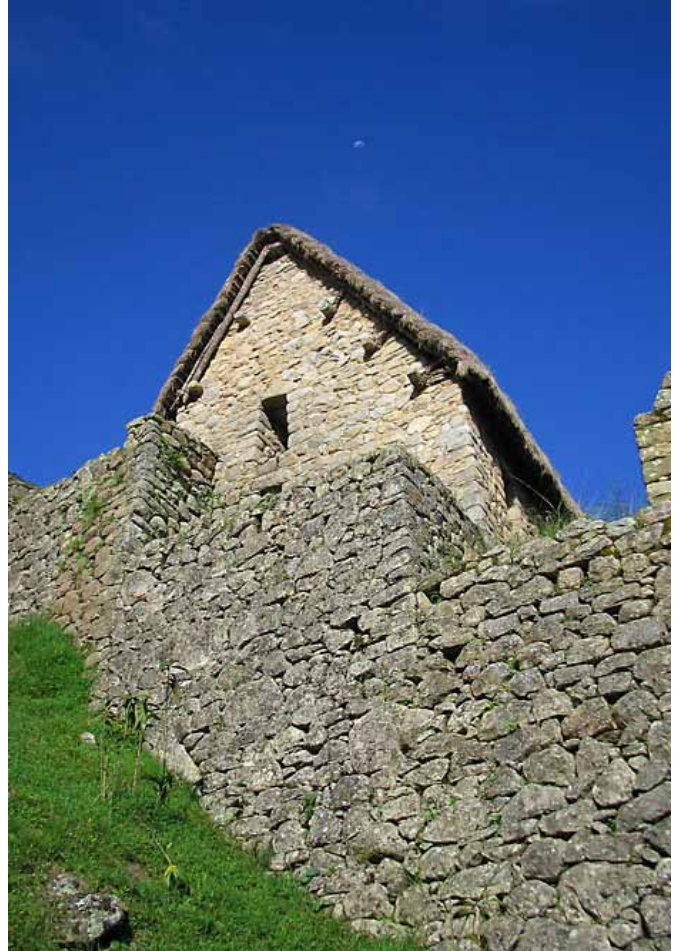
Transfer to Cusco airport, flight back to Lima and transfer in at arrival to Lima. End of our services..
