



Get Closer to Nature | 22 days

Colonial and modern Lima • Pachacamac • Villa swamps tour • Ballestas Island tour and Ica desert tour • Nazca Lines over flight, aqueducts and the cemetery of Chauchilla tours • Arequipa city tour and Colca Canyon tour • Sacred Valley of the Incas tour • overnight in Aguas Calientes and Machu Picchu private tour • 7 days Manu National Park jungle safari

Suggested Itinerary

Day 1 | Lima

Transfer in to your hotel in Lima.

Day 2 | Lima

Early morning breakfast and transfer to Villa swamps, paradise for birdwatchers and nature lovers with more than 100 species of birds, then we visit Pachacamac archaeological complex, visit to the ceremonial center and return to Lima. After lunch, city tour with visits to Miraflores district, downtown Lima, the Main, the Cathedral, and San Francisco Convent.

Day 3 | Lima - Paracas

Free time during the morning to walk around the Miraflores district and transfer to the bus station in the afternoon to take a bus to Pisco, 4 hours south of Lima, stay at the Zarcillo Paradise Hotel on the coast of Paracas bay.

Day 4 | Paracas - Nazca

We take an idyllic boat trip to Ballestas islands. This spectacular environment is considered the Galapagos Islands of Peru; thousands of birds and sea lions will be just a few meters in front of you. At midday, we take a private bus through the Ica desert, stopping at Lake Huacachina for a sand dune experience, arriving in Nazca town at night.

Day 5 | Nazca - Arequipa

Early morning over flight of the mysterious Nazca Lines. An amazing Pacha Manca – a traditional Inca Ceremonial Lunch included; in the afternoon, visit to the aqueducts and Chauchilla cemetery tour, which conserves hundreds of pre-Inca mummies and tapestries. At night, a very comfortable bus to the White City of Arequipa.

Day 6 | Arequipa

Transfer in & check in, city tour in the afternoon that includes: the monastery of Santa Catalina, Yanahuara and Carmen Alto districts, the cathedral and La Compañía church and cloister.

Day 7 | Colca Canyon

Early morning departure to Colca Canyon, visit to the reserve Aguada Blanca and Salinas in the way at 4800 meters above sea level, arrival to the village of Chivay at midday. After lunch, relaxing afternoon in the thermal baths. Night free.



Day 8 | Arequipa

Early in the morning we depart to Cruz Del Condor, border cliff of the deepest canyon on earth, where we'll spot the Andean Condor, we'll also visit various towns and observation points of the canyon along the way, return to Chivay at midday, lunch in Chivay and return to Arequipa. Arrival to Arequipa in the afternoon.

Day 9 | Arequipa - Cusco - Pisac

Transfer to Arequipa airport and flight to Cusco in the morning. At arrival to Cusco transfer to our hotel in Pisac town on the sacred Valley of the Incas for acclimatizing. Afternoon walk into town and the nearby points of interest.

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Day 10 | Pisac - Ollantaytambo

In the morning visit to the archeological complex of Pisac and walk to downtown Pisac, and then free time to shop in its famous handicraft market. Lunch included on the way from Pisac to Urubamba in Tunupa restaurant (novoandina cuisine), visit to artist Pablo Seminario's house and to the Ollantaytambo complex. Overnight in Ollantaytambo.

Day 11 | Ollantaytambo - Machu Picchu

Morning train to Aguas Calientes, at arrival transfer to our hotel. In the afternoon visit to Mandor water falls. Return to Aguas Calientes and overnight there.

Day 12 | Machu Picchu - Cusco

Morning visit to Machu Picchu complex at sunrise and then free time to enjoy the complex on your own. In the afternoon return to Aguas Calientes and train to Ollantaytambo, from there bus to our hotel in Cusco. Night free.

Day 13 | Cusco

City tour in the morning which includes visit to Sacsayhuaman, Qenco Puca Pucara and Tambomachay complexes, as well as the Temple of the Sun or Koricancha and the Cathedral in Cusco. Free afternoon. We include dinner with the delicious cuisine of fallen Angel restaurant. Night free.

Day 14 to 20 | Manu National Park

Seven days to discover the wonders of this jungle paradise, a unique place on earth that holds and protects the most diverse wildlife in the world. Optional downhill biking from the Andes to the rainforest, rafting, search of wildlife and plenty of hikes. Returning to Cusco on day 20. Check our Manu National Park itinerary.

Day 21 | Cusco

Your last free day in this beautiful city can be spent buying local crafts, taking those final sites on your free tourist ticket, or just enjoying the excellent restaurants.

Day 22 | Lima

Our adventure finishes at the hotel after breakfast; transfer to the Cusco airport and flight back to Lima. End of tour!.



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
