Suggested Itinerary

Day 1 | Lima

Transfer in to your hotel in Lima.

Day 2 | Lima

Early breakfast and transfer to the Villa swamps, paradise for birdwatchers and nature lovers with more than 100 species of birds, then we visit the Pachacamac archaeological complex, visit to the ceremonial center and return to Lima. After lunch city tour with visits to Miraflores district, downtown Lima, the Main Square (Plaza de Armas), the Cathedral, and San Francisco Convent.

Day 3 | Lima – Chiclayo

Transfer to the Lima airport and flight to Chiclayo. Transfer to the hotel. In the morning we will visit the incredible Tucume ruins, then the Lord of Sipan Royal Museum and the Sican Pyramid area, back to Chiclayo in the late afternoon. The lunch is included at Lambayeque.

Day 4 & 5 | Chiclayo – Chaparrí - Chiclayo

2 days in the Chaparri private reserved, this reserve counts with the biggest amount of endemic birds in Peru, where they have a project to re-insert the spectacle bear and white winged guan. Return to Chiclayo on day 5 and bus to Mancora.

Day 6 | Chiclayo - Máncora

Transfer to the hotel in Máncora. Free time to enjoy this wonderful beach or any other beaches, such as Punta Sal, Punta Mero, Cancas etc. We offer you a variety of beach activities, such us surfing, diving, snorkeling, trekking, and bird watching in the area and more.

Day 7 | Máncora – Tumbes – Zorritos

In the morning transfer in private car to the district of Villa Primavera (10 minutes from Peru/Ecuador borderline). Arrival to "Puerto 25" and visit to the National Sanctuary. The visit is made in a rowboat. We will stop in a platform in the mangrove and make a guided walk about 50 meters to enjoy nature and environment. Return to the town and transfer to the hotel in Zorritos just in front of this beautiful sea.



Day 18 | Arequipa - Cusco

Early flight to Cusco, the capital of the Inca empire. Free day! There's so much to see in Cusco. Don't forget shopping at Barrio de San Blas!.

Day 19 | Cusco – Pisac - Ollantaytambo

In the morning visit to the archeological complex of Pisac and walk to downtown Pisac, and then free time to shop in the famous handicraft market here. Lunch included on the way Pisac- Urubamba in Tunupa restaurant (novoandina cuisine), in the afternoon visit to the Ollantaytambo complex.

Day 20 | Ollantaytambo – Machu Picchu

Morning train to Aguas Calientes, at arrival transfer to our hotel. For the afternoon we have the visit to Mandor water falls. Return to Aguas Calientes and overnight there.

Day 21 | Machu Picchu - Cusco

Morning visit to Machu Picchu complex at sunrise and then free time to enjoy the complex on your own. In the afternoon return to Aguas Calientes and train to Ollantaytambo, bus to the hotel in Cusco. Night free.

Day 8 | Zorritos – Reserved Zone

Breakfast early in the morning and transfer to the city of Tumbes in a 4x4 van. We will cross Pampas de Hospital to get to the Reserved Area of Tumbes, which has a Pacific Tropical Forest ecosystem. After arrival to Caucho, we will camp and have lunch. In the afternoon, walk along Quebrada de las Pavas. Dinner and fire lit.

Day 9 | Reserved Zone - Zorritos

Very early in the morning, before breakfast, walk along Quebrada la Unión, where the Howling Monkey of Tumbes is frequently seen. Breakfast and walk to the crystalline water pond where we will be able to enjoy nature. Lunch and optional bicycle ride to Pampas de Hospital. Transfer to Zorritos beach. Free night.

Day 10 | Zorritos – Lima

Transfer to the Tumbes airport and flight to Lima. Transfer in to the Hotel in Miraflores district. Afternoon free.

Day 11 | Lima – Pisco - Paracas

Free time during the morning to walk the Miraflores district, transfer to the bus station in the afternoon, bus to Pisco, 4 hours south of Lima, stay at the Zarcillo Paradise Hotel on the coast.

Day 12 | Paracas - Nazca

This morning we take an idyllic boat trip to the Ballestas islands. This spectacular environment is considered the Galapagos Islands of Peru; thousands of birds and sea lions will be just a few meters in front of you. At midday, we take a private bus through the Ica desert, arriving in Nazca town at night.

Day 13 | Nazca - Arequipa

Early morning over flight of the mysterious Nazca Lines. An amazing Pacha Manca - a traditional Inka Ceremonial Lunch included; during the afternoon, the aqueducts and Chauchilla cemetery tour, which conserves hundreds of pre-Inca mummies and tapestries. At night, a very comfortable bus to the White City of Arequipa.

Day 14 | Arequipa

Transfer in & check in, city tour in the afternoon that includes: the monastery of Santa Catalina, Yanahuara and Carmen Alto districts, the cathedral and La Compañía church and cloister.

Days 15, 16, & 17 | Colca Canyon

Three days in the deepest canyon on Earth. You will enjoy the best hot springs in Peru, hikes through the Canyon, the flight of the huge condors, the most remote villages and a unique environment. Back to Arequipa on day 17.

Day 22 | Cusco

City tour in the morning which includes visit to Sacsayhuaman, Qenko, Puca Pucara and Tambomachay complexes, as well as the Temple of the Sun or Koricancha and the Cathedral in Cusco. Afternoon free.

Day 23 | Cusco - Puno

Incredible scenery on the road to Puno. A local bus and some stops on the way will show you the real face of the Peruvian Andes. Puno is located on the shores of the sacred Lake Titicaca, at almost 4000 meters above sea level.

Day 24 | Taquile Island

A day's visit through the magic of the highest navigable lake in the world. The floating islands of the Uros and the beauty of Lake Titicaca. Back to Puno in the afternoon.

Day 25 | Puno - Lima

Transfer to the Puno airport and flight to Lima. End to our services.
